Lock Down and Lock Out Policies

We are now being notified by the city of Ft. Wayne of situations that may require us to institute Lock Downs or Lock Outs of our facility to ensure the safety of the children. We will monitor and assess whether we feel a situation is threatening to our location and students. A Lock Out is when no one will be allowed to enter or leave the building. The window blinds will be closed and all exterior doors locked. Students will still be allowed to move about the building. Should this happen at dismissal time, students will not be allowed to leave until we have been given the all clear. A Lock Down is when all students will be confined to the room they are in, all interior and exterior doors will be locked and the blinds closed. No one will be allowed to enter or leave the building and carline will be delayed. Should either one of those situations occur, we will send an email notifying you of the incident. If you have questions, please let us know.
